For the second month in a row the Hawg Hunters were greeted by plenty of the blowy stuff. Hats being blown off and gusts nearly takin fat guys off the front of the boat (ok that was me) were part of the post tournament story line. The nice thing about CJ Strike is you can almost always find a place out of the wind. Problem is, those places don't always hold fish. On the non boater side, Tiffany Smith smashed a nice 11.94 pound bag fishin behind Josh Dallas to take top honors. Second place was the 9.75 pound sack Brady Smith brought in. Third goes out to Carl Seeman who managed 4 fish for 8.77 pounds fishing as a guest of Nick Rudzki.

Top teams this month were Josh Dallas an Tiffany Smith with 25.88 pounds, Scott Lepka and Johanna Dallas with 18.25 pounds and Tim Parrish and Cody Parrish with 18.05 pounds.

Big fish for the day was brought in by Scott Lepka, a nice 4.95 pound smallmouth followed by Jon Lindstrom's 4.36 pound anchor fish.

With his second win in a row, Jon Lindstrom has put himself in a good place in the Angler of the Year race. He's got a few hammers behind him and quite a few tournaments ahead of him though, so Jon's gonna have to keep it up to pull it off. Pretty darned good start though Jon!

In our rookie of the year race, Johanna Dallas. who beat Marshall Carruthers in this tournament, has jumped out to a 9 point lead over Alex Stone. Again, a lot of fishin yet to happen but Johanna is off to a good start!
